The Europe House in Nîmes – Europe Direct Centre would like to host 2 volunteers for a project of **11 months** in Nîmes, a south-east city of France. The volunteers will participate to the activities of a High school in the city centre of Nîmes.

The objective of the project is to facilitate the intercultural exchange between the volunteers and students. Actors of the educational service, their activities will be to create and animate workshops for young people using non-formal learning methods.

Most of the activities of the volunteers will be in link with European languages, non-formal learning and information about Europe.

Other activities will be linked with the House of Europe: workshops with children, multicultural events, informations stands..

#### **Main tasks of the volunteer:**

- support the International relations office in communication tasks such as contacting foreign partners, preparation of students' mobility (application, interviews...)
- create video/graphic contents for the high school, to promote mobility projects
- Support in teaching European languages (assist language teachers in Spanish or English) using non-formal learning methods ;
- give information about Europe, promote mobility programmes and support the students (with their mobility research)...
- Active participation in events and projects organised at the school and/or with other partners;
- Helping students' preparation for their mobility abroad – research of hosting companies, accommodation;
- implementing new ideas/activities such as environmental awareness workshops
- Link with the activities of The House of Europe dealing with youth (organizing intercultural events)

A time dedicated at the elaboration of the volunteer's personal projects, important part of the European Solidarity Corps, will be offered to them with the support and the expertise of the High school and Europe House team.

## **Volunteer profile sought:**

The Europe House in Nîmes and the high school want to host European volunteers in the team in order to add skills, especially with the students of the school to be more European and international. From the volunteers, the Europe House is expecting their desire to give to the public their knowledge and enthusiasm for the intercultural dialogue and intercultural learning. European information and sensitization is more credible if it's made by young people from other European countries who believe in the European Union and who have a strong motivation to participate to the programs that are proposed, as well as learning foreign languages.

Candidates should have basic knowledge in French to understand and be understood + knowledges in English and/or Spanish.

Their motivation, their capacity on bringing enthusiasm during their intervention, especially for the youngsters, and their understanding of the pedagogy and the contact will be important criteria.

They will have to be flexible, mobile and to be able to adapt in every specific situation and every type of audience.

## **Description of the volunteering**

Aimed to encourage the mobility and the implication of youngsters from 18 to 30 years old, the European Solidarity Corps (ESC) helps to serve a non-profit organization or a public body for general interest. Fully funded by the European Solidarity Corps program (except for a part of the journey if necessary), the stay is totally free of charge for the volunteer.

## **Accommodations and practicalities:**

The working time of the volunteer will be around 35 hours per week. Working time will be from Monday to Friday from 8am to 5 pm (2 hours break for lunch). Week-end are free days, unless for punctual activity that are taking place on Saturday and/or on Sunday. In this case, the volunteer will be able to take some more free days during the week. His/her holiday's projects will have to be organized according to his tutor at least two weeks before. The volunteers will receive a monthly allowance for their food, but can also eat in another high school's self-restaurant. The volunteers will be hosted in a shared flat (with other volunteers or erasmus students/interns) or student residency close to the centre, shops...

The volunteers will receive 6€/day for pocket money and 8€/day for food.

TRAVEL GRANT: between 180 € and 360€ max (according to the distance).
